## CATCHY COMMENTS

Flatheads Rule!! In case you haven't noticed, all four current freshwater division leaders have caught flatheads. It is rare indeed to have one species dominate our competition at this late stage of the angling year. The latest to join this elite group is **Bob Brown**, who released a club record 25-0 on 4 general in late July that scored 500 points. The other two desperados in the group are **Fred Murray** and **Jim Farrell**. Fred's 24-8 club record flathead on 2-spin scored a shocking 816 points back in December. Even better in my book was his club record, 646 point 21-0 on 4-fly in February that could have been a world record. Jim's dandy was a club record 21-0 on 4-plug that produced 525 points!

Bob's fishing partner, **Fred Cousins**, also released a nice flathead. Fred's 23-8 on 4 general that scored 470 points was the top entry at the August meeting for angler of the month. **Eddy Johnston** placed second with 430 points for his 14-0 gar on 2 general. **Bob Shepherd** was third with 311 points for a club record 14-0 musky on 6-plug. Bob also released two other smaller muskies on a second trip to the New. Congratulations to all!

The only other freshwater news comes from Alaska, where **Stuart Lee** set three new club records on fly, fishing the Kanektok River. Stuart's 9-8 coho salmon set a record for 8-tippet and his 11-8 coho is our best ever on 12-tippet. Then, Stuart stooped to "trash fishing", when he went after the bottom feeders that were eating the dead salmon in the river. His 6-0 "carp", (aka - rainbow trout) was a club record on 8-tippet! Sounds like a great trip to me!

In saltwater, a few medium amberjack were entered by **Scott Davis**, **Reggie White** and **Fred Cousins**. Scott's 25-0 on 8-plug is the species cup leader. Scott also released a 47-inch cobia in early September that jumped out of his net! Sounds like a mean fish! Three more club record croakers were entered this month. The largest was a 2-9 on 8 general from the York River by **Glenn Carter**. **Danny Noland** pulled a 2-4 off the "Texaco" wreck using 2-plug. **Scott Johnston** plied the Piankatank for a 2-2 on 6-fly. **Quentin Corbett** says the Spanish were thick as fleas over Labor Day at Cape Point on Hatteras! His best was a 2-8 from the surf.

**Dr. Jim Wright** now leads the "lunker" list with an 8-4 flounder on 12 general. He also had a 7-0 on wire line that was disqualified. Remember, folks, you must abide by club rules in order to have entries accepted for any records or club competition. Dr. Jim also released a 78-

inch shark near Oyster. He passes on some news of interest as well. On an August trip off Virginia Beach, he caught golden tilefish that weighed 20 and 45 pounds on squid baits. Although tilefish is not a club recognized species, it is certainly an unusual and noteworthy catch.

## Angling Rules Notice

New Basic Weight tables for freshwater and saltwater are included in this newsletter. The new basic weights go into effect on December 1<sup>st</sup>. The new basic weights are expressed in decimal format as pounds to the nearest hundredth of a pound. This change should simplify the calculation of points by eliminating the need to convert the basic weight from pounds and ounces to decimals. Such conversion will still be needed for the weight of the fish since most club certified scales read in pounds and ounces.

Saltwater Basic weights were unchanged except for the conversion to decimals. Freshwater basic weights have been revised across-the-board using a standardized method with specified relationships between the tackle divisions (general, spin, plug and fly). The combination of using the new method and decimals allowed us to spot old basic weights that were "out of line" and make corrections. Special care was taken to not weaken the requirements for achieving FWE, SWE or Master Angler status as pertaining to required fish entries. The new basic weights are reasonably close to the old ones in most cases. Some reductions in basic weights were made at the higher line weights for several species, but in general, basic weights for 2-pound line did not change significantly. The exception was flathead catfish, where basic weights were raised across all line weights and tackle classes. Please review these tables and address any questions or concerns you may have to any member of the Angling Rules - Basic Weight Committee (Dennis Cline, Glenn Carter, Scott Davis, Scott Johnston, Danny Noland and Elly Robinson).

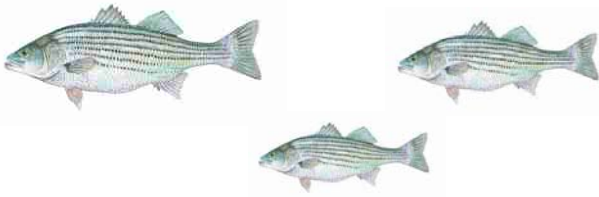
