August Membership Meeting – James River Cat Fishin' With Capt. Mike Ostrander

At the August 22nd Membership Meeting, we are being treated to a program about cat fishing' in the James River. VAC Member and President of The James River Fishing School, Capt. Mike Ostrander, will present a program about tackle and techniques used to hook catfish in the James River. This fishery is pretty much active year 'round. For all VAC anglers living in the Richmond Area, this fishery lends its self to a fishing trip from of a couple of hours on the water to an all day adventure in enjoyable and often rewarded angling. If you want to try out what you learn and your boat is laid up or infested with the demons of bad luck, check with Mike. He guides cat fishing trips on the James. Will the GPS coordinates of Fred's (Cousin's) James River Honey Hole be revealed?? Be sure to come and find out. Bring a buddy too.

At the September Membership Meeting, Dr. Julie Ball, an experienced angler who was recently appointed as the latest IGFA Representative for the Commonwealth, will be our featured speaker. Wives and significant others are invited to hear Julie's presentation. Details on her subject will appear here next month. October will feature another program providing information on other local fresh waters that are close by and worth a try. VAC Member and Chief of Fisheries of the DGIF, Gary Martell, is working up a program featuring information on productive fresh water fishing spots that are a 90 minute or less drive from the Richmond Area and that have produced their share of citation fresh water fish.

The Leadership of the VAC thanks Members Buddy and Danny Noland for their fine presentation at the July Membership Meeting a program about angling for cobia.

Calendars – Mostly Gone

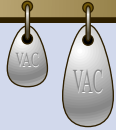

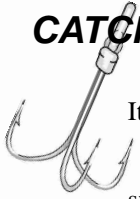

CATCHY COMMENTS

It's hard to believe, but it's the middle of August and the summer is winding down. The good news is that the fish are fattening up for the swim south when the first Northeaster hits in September. In another two weeks, it's VT football, dove and resident goose hunting, followed by bow season, so lets get on the water before all these other distractions get here.

Fred Cousins has been dominating the **Ken Kinnard Angler of the Month** award for the past several months, but **Elly Robinson** has decided to give Fred some competition. Elly took first place honors at the July meeting with a 29-8 Barracuda on 6# plug for 458 points. Fred held on to second place with a 16-0 Flathead Catfish on 4# General for 216 points. **Stuart Lee** took third place honors with an 11-0 Landlocked Striped Bass on 8# plug for 183 points. Elly's barracuda took over the Specie and Plug Division lead and Stuart's LL striper is the new specie leader.

If the VAC gave an award for "**Captain of the Year**", it would have to go the **Capt. Bruce Henderson** for 2006. First, Bruce has had Elly wreck fishing with him out of Hatteras on several occasions this summer. Next, Bruce has been putting Elly on some good fish over these wrecks. The combination of having Elly on board and catching fish.....MAKES FOR A LONG DAY. Rumor has it that Bruce is looking for a Sport Fisherman with an enclosed bridge and sound proof glass for the 2007 season. On Bruce and Elly's last trip, Elly had a 29-0 Barracuda on 8# spin for 362 points, and followed that up with specie leading 16-4 African Pompano on 6# spin for 361 points. **Bruce and Jim Sheffield** hit the wrecks on another day and Jim came away with a club record 29-0 Amberjack on 6# plug for 414 points. Jim's amberjack also takes the specie lead. It's good to see the cards coming if from Hatteras.

Bill Carter has a new club record Tarpon from the waters around Goodland, Fla. Bill entered a 65-0 Tarpon, on 12# general for 282 points. Great catch Bill. Watch for some Tarpon entries from the Eastern Shore of Va. this season. Rumors are that this is the best tarpon season ever from this area. If I was looking to catch one, I'd be chartering **Glenn Sides**. Glenn has been pretty successful this season. News has come in from up North that **Steve Luterek** is having one of his best years ever for Walleye on New York's Lake Erie. Steve's most recent entry is a club record 9-6 Walleye on 12# general for 236 points. Steve reported that there has been some really big Walleye caught this year. This could be good news for the Oak Orchard Salmon and Brown Trout this fall if some club members are heading up.

Tight lines and keep the entry cards coming in.

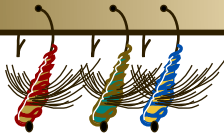

The View From Up North By Steve Luterek August 2006

Lake Erie Walleye fishing has been nothing but phenomenal this year. The shallow water night bite in May was great and the nights were absolutely gorgeous. Outings usually resulted in limit catches.

After the water warmed up, the walleye night bite turned off and fish were found in heavy concentrations in selected areas of the lake, in deeper water, again allowing for limit catches more times than not. The early bite starting at 5:30 – 6:00 AM resulted in limits of 18” to 28” and the occasional bigger fish by 9:00 AM.

We fished a Walleye tournament run by “Southtowns Walleye”, which ran a week starting June 10, and boated and kept 58 Walleye up to and including many 8 pounders, and released 30 or so. Approximately 1,000 fishermen enter this tournament every year and first prize is \$12,000 with payouts to 200 places.

The top ten fish official weight ranged from 12.64 pounds to 10.76 pounds. The minimum length for a fish that could be weighed in was 26”. The top five fish are worth some good money, and the balance of 195 fish are worth \$50.00 each. We had many weighers, but unlike most years we did not finish in the top 200 to help pay our expenses.

This is a fun tournament and many people from out of state camp out for the week and fish all week. Information on this fun event as well as club information can be found at www.southtownswalleye.org.

This might be a good excuse for some VAC club members to come fishing for Walleye next year. There are many good hotels and campgrounds around the launch sites.

Another fine example of the walleye fishery is the 9 pound 6 oz walleye I am submitting this month to break my previous club record of 9 pounds.

The trolling method used on the open lake is to find bait or marks, and then trolling from 1.8 – 2.6 MPH on the GPS, running diving planer options that include Dipsy Divers, Jet Divers, in line weights, wire line, IGFA mono or braided super line with diving planers and various lengths of lead core to get the baits to various depths. We use planer boards, downriggers or in line boards to get the baits away from the boat and develop a good spread of lures. Lure choices will be various types and colors of stick baits, but predominately various size and style of blades on worm harnesses trolled behind our diving planers.

Perch have been hard to find, and remain elusive. The smallmouth bass fishery remains one of the best in the country and one of these days I intend to leave the walleye, salmon and trout alone and try the bass fishing.

August brings the Trout and Salmon fishery in the open waters of the lakes to its peak. More on this next month.

An interesting note is Field and Stream has Buffalo, New York listed in its “Americas Top 20 Destinations” for fishing. If ranking was based strictly on inland/freshwater fishing options, Buffalo would be in the top 5 if not number one due to the variety and quality of catches available within 30 miles of our city. Lake Erie, Lake Ontario, inland streams and inland lakes offer many opportunities.

If any member is interested in swapping trips, or just some general information on the fishing opportunities in the western New York area, I will be glad to help them. I will try to submit items of interest in my area, for the newsletter if there is continued interest.

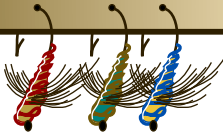
