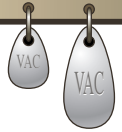
### New Member Matt Balazik Voted Into Membership

## CATCHY COMMENTS

The *Flathead Catfish* fishing has paid off for three of our anglers as they were awarded recently with IGFA World Records for their efforts. **Bob Brown** received two world records. One for his 31-0 pound *Flathead* on 6# Fly and another for his 28-0 on 16# Fly. **Parks Rountrey's** record is a 29-8 pound on 4# fly. Last but not least is **Glenn Carter's** world record 28-8 pound *Flathead Catfish* on 8# Fly. Congratulations to all on the Fly catches.

The month started out slow with only a few entries because of the high winds and rain. **Jamie Pitts** continues to catch the big fish with a 34 pound *Cobia* caught at the CBBT on a bucktail on 20# line. But, since we do not have a 20# plug category, I entered the catch in 20 general which gave **Jamie** 130 points for the catch.

**Rob Choi** had a big month with five fresh water entries. He caught a *Smallmouth Bass* with a Gulp Worm on 2# spin for 112 points and several *Largemouth*. **Rob** also released a *Rainbow Trout* in the Great Smokey Mountains Park in Tennessee. His best catch was a new 2# spin "club record" for *Channel Catfish*. The fish weighed 6-4 pounds and was worth 250 points.

**Bruce Henderson** was fishing off Oregon Inlet and had several nice entries. His 1 pound 12 ounce *Black Sea Bass* on 4# spin takes the specie lead for *Sea Bass*. **Bruce** also had a 4-8 pound "club record" *Blueline Tilefish* on 12# general.

**Parks Rountrey** fished the James River with "corn" as the preferred bait and caught an 11 pound 8 ounce *Carp* on 2# general for 287 points. Hard to top last months *Flathead* fishing.

**Scott Johnston** spent some time in September fishing the non-local waters of the Detroit River in Michigan. Using 4# fly, Scott caught a *Rock Bass* worth 101 points and his best catch was a 4 pound 8 ounce *Smallmouth Bass* for a new "club record" worth 409 points. I'm not sure, but I believe **Scott** might have tried to slip in a 2-14 pound *Smallmouth* for the 16# fly club record. The fish was worth 99 points because we round "down" for entries and not "up"! An entry must be worth 100 points minimum to be a club record.

It appears that **Eddy Johnston** must have cohered **Elly Robinson** away from the TV for a day of fishing at Rudee Inlet. **Elly** considers himself a college football expert and emails a daily "blog" on ACC sports.

Both fish were worth 185 points with the plug entry being the “early entry”. **Eddy** also entered a nice 2-2 pound *Speckled Trout* for 141 points on 2# spin from Rudee Inlet.

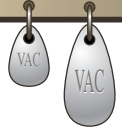

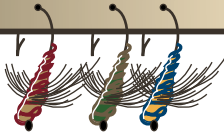

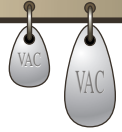

## Upcoming Angling Events

### Virginia / North Carolina Striped Bass Tournament December 15-31 (no blow date)

Our tourney will be at peak time for big winter Rockfish. Drifting live baits or conventional trolling are preferred methods for the heaviest fish. For light tackle points - various soft plastic baits are effective on light spinning and plug gear. Fly fishing is also productive when you can find fish near the surface. A number of club members like Cape Charles and CBBT areas this time of year, but you can fish any Virginia or North Carolina salt waters. Remember - *this is our first tournament for the new angling year* – so be sure to plan on fishing.

Two ways to win! We will recognize three places for heaviest weight fish and three places for highest point fish.

First = 3 pts.  
Second = 2 pts.  
Third = 1 pt.

These points will apply towards the annual Salt Water Tournament Angler of the Year competition.

One angler can win 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in both weight and points divisions by entering multiple fish.

Tournament First Place Awards for weight and points - Anglers Choice: Traditional cup, \$40 Greentop gift certificate or a VAC Banquet ticket.

NOTES: A fish can be entered by weight or points (angler must declare which category) but not both ways for 1 fish.

You can not change the entry category once you have registered it with the Chairman.
